

# **LASER PROCEDURES**

## Pre-Procedure & Post Procedure Instructions

#### **Pre-Procedure**

- Review your medical history. We will discuss any medical conditions and medications as well as any cosmetic procedures you have had in the past.
- Physical exam we will inspect your skin and treatment areas to determine realistic changes that can be made and results to be expected. If hair is present in the area of interest, we will shave the area.
- Expectations we will discuss your expectation, motivation, and any potential risks.
- Medication we will prescribe any antiviral medication if you have having laser resurfacing and have a history of HSV1 infections (cold sores)
- Sun exposure we will discuss current amounts of sun exposure. One month prior to the
  procedure it is important to reduce exposure to the sun. If a patient has an unhealthy
  amount of sun exposure the procedure can result in irregular pigmentation in treated
  areas.

# **Procedure**

- Non-ablative laser resurfacing is performed in-office.
- The treatment area will be cleaned and your eyes will either e closed or covered depending on the laser type. If needed, we will apply a numbing cream 30 minutes prior to the procedure to ensure a comfortable experience.
- Skin will not be removed during the procedure.
- Procedures typically take between 15 and 90 minutes, depending on laser type and size of the treated area.
- For best results, treatments are to be scheduled in a series with 3-4 weeks of time inbetween treatments.

## **Post-Procedure**

- Skin may be red or swollen after a laser treatment.
- Ice packs may be used as needed for the first 24 hours.
- Over the counter pain relievers may be taken.
- Within 48 hours you may return to normal activities and apply makeup. The is to be NO
  excessive sweating or working out 24 yours after a laser hair removal treatment, as this
  may cause redness, irritation, blistering, and bleeding.
- There is to be NO excessive sun exposure for 24 hours after a laser hair removal treatment, as this may cause redness, irritation, blistering, and bleeding. 48 hours post treatment you may resume typical activities involving sun exposure with proper sun protection.
